

General Rules of Registration

Club Membership shall be open to all gymnastics clubs in Scotland who wish to participate in the regulation and administration of the various sports and competitive activities incorporating gymnastics at all levels. Any club may apply to become a Club Member by applying for membership in accordance with the Memorandum and Articles of Association.

It is a requirement of this category that each Club Member's gymnasts, office bearers, coaches, judges, technical officials and helpers become Members or are registered with the Company in accordance with the Company's rules of registration prior to 1 October in each year.

All applicants wishing to become a Member or a Club Member shall be required to complete the application form in the format(s) provided by SG, and provide any relevant information in support of such application. In completing the application form, the applicant agrees (and where the form is submitted on behalf of a club, all the members of the club shall be deemed to be agree) to be bound by the Rules and accept the policies, rules and conditions in relation to membership and the payment of fees, and generally the terms of these Articles. Applications to become a Member or a Club Member must be accompanied by the appropriate annual membership fee.

Photography Statement

Scottish Gymnastics (SG) aim is to create a fun and safe environment for children, young adults, parents/guardians, coaches and officials to enjoy our sport. We fully expect and encourage action photographs to be taken as these provide fantastic records and memories for families to keep. However, with the increase of gymnastics action photographs appearing in publications and on the internet, we must all take the time to ensure these photographs are suitable for publication. Photos include any form of video or still image, including those taken by mobile phone. Guidance on this issue is provided in the SG Child Protection Policy, available on the SG website.

All photographs and videos taken at SG events and competitions may be used by SG for relevant coaching or promotional activities. Examples of promotional activities could be images being displayed on our website or social media channels. No personal information will be displayed with the image and it will be displayed in accordance with the SG Child Protection Policy, and as considered reasonable for promotional publicity purposes. These purposes will be directly in connection with SG events marketing or development programmes. The material will be used in a way that it does not suggest that the gymnast/group directly endorses a particular product or service.
