Pathway for TeamGym Judging (applications from judges in other disciplines will be considered on merit at all levels)

Level	Pre-knowledge / Experience	Criterion for Attending Course	Allowed judging
Club Judge	Current full membership BG (Bronze). Prerequisite - intro course to TG judging. Worked within a Club as performer or helper.	Over the age of 15 years. Current qualified or helper coach or other interested party. Aware of the British Modified Code of Points.	May judge at Local or Regional competitions for events using BG GfA Levels 6 and 5 rules, as part of E-panel.
Regional Judge	Current full membership BG (Bronze). Current Club TG judge (Min 1 year) or revalidating Regional TG Judge.	Over the age of 17 years. Actively judged at competitions in the preceding year. Good knowledge and understanding of UEG Code of Points together with the British Modified Code.	May judge at Local or Regional events using BG Modified Code rules. Plus by invitation, at National events as part of E-panel.
National Judge	Current full, joint or life membership BG (Gold). Current Regional Judge (Min 2 year) or revalidating National TG judge, or National Judge in another gymnastics discipline.	Over the age of 18 years. Judged at least five competitions at Regional level or higher over 2 years. A sound knowledge and understanding of the UEG Code of Points and the British Modified Code.	May judge at National events as well as Regional and Local events.
Brevet Judge	Current full, joint or life membership BG (Gold). Current National TG Judge (Min 2 cycles) or revalidating Brevet TG Judge.	Limited number of places available per Federation. Nominated by TGTC and selected by British Gymnastics. Judges should have been actively judging over 2 cycles.	May judge at Regional, National and International events, if selected.
