



Role Descriptor: Performance / Development Coordinator

General Description

The Performance / Development Coordinator will be formally appointed to the Technical Panel (TP) for a period of four years, to match the Commonwealth Games periodisation, and may be subsequently appointed for further terms of office.

The Performance / Development Coordinator will, in conjunction with the Head of Development and Head of Performance & Education, be responsible for supporting the growth of the discipline in addition to the progressive development and performance levels of the discipline through liaising with the Development and Performance team.

Specific Duties and Responsibilities

The Performance / Development Coordinator will:

- Establish and create, in partnership with the BG National Technical Committee, the discipline specific gymnast pathway
- Support clubs in the discipline to provide sustainable performance development environments
- Support general growth of the discipline through development activities, in partnership with the SG Development team
- Establish and deliver (where required) roadshows to support new clubs to introduce the discipline for their members
- Attend BG National Programme Review Group (NPRG) meetings to represent Scottish Gymnastics, and report back to Heads of Development, Education & Performance

Desired Criteria for Performance / Development Coordinator

- Good organisational, administration, planning and IT skills
- Sound knowledge and understanding of the discipline
- Minimum UKCC Level 2 Qualification in the discipline
- Respected within the discipline community
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
