Competition Format	<p>The finals will be offered for to those aged below in year of competition: Bronze Classic Challenge: 10+ years (2011+) Silver Classic Challenge: 12+ years (2009+) Gold Classic Challenge: 14+ years (2007+)</p> <p>The first six gymnasts in each category will represent the region at national finals. The seventh-place gymnast will be nominated reserve.</p> <p>There will be 6 in a team, 6 to work on each piece. The team score will be the total of the 4 best scores on Vault, Bars, Beam and Floor</p>

Gymnasts eligibility for selection	<p>Gymnasts are eligible for consideration provided they:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hold a current Scottish Gymnastics silver membership • Comply with Scottish Gymnastics UKAD Clean Sport policy at all times • Only represent the region in which their club is situated • Meet the in-age age criteria for their category <p>Gymnasts must attend the qualification event.</p>		
The 'Team' and Organisation	<p>The 'team' means those who are selected by Scottish Gymnastics and includes gymnasts, coaches, judges, nominated reserve, team manager and any other relevant staff/personnel.</p> <p>Gymnasts and personal coaches will travel independently to and from the competition venue.</p>		
Appeals	<p>The appeals process is only applicable to de-selection relating to injury/illness/competition readiness which can be found on www.scottishgymnastics.org</p>		
Entry information and costs	<p>The entry fee per gymnast is £37. The reserve gymnasts does not need to pay the entry fee unless they are required to compete.</p> <p>Club's must complete the online entry form confirming their gymnast's attendance and paying their entry fee by Monday 4 October at 12 noon.</p>
