

Numbers of Judges per Club

The following are recommendations as to the judging requirements per Club, related to the level of gymnasts within the Club:

- **New clubs**
 - 1 or 2 judges at level 1 [Local Judge (Floor and Vault)]
- **Developing clubs** (I.e. Clubs with gymnasts progressing on to NDPs)
 - 2 judges at level 1, and/or 2 [Local, and Club]
 - 1 judge at level 3 [Regional Judge]
- **Mainstream clubs** (I.e. Clubs with gymnasts aiming for Elite grades)
 - 2 judges at level 1 [Local]
 - 2 judges at level 2 [Club]
 - 2 judges at level 3. [Regional Judge]
 - and identify a judge who can progress to level 4 [National]
- **Clubs performing at National and/or FIG rules level**
 - Should have judges at each level [Local, Club and Regional]
 - 1 National (level 4) judge
 - And an International Brevet (level 5) judge (or identify a judge who can progress to this level)

There can be some correlation with coaching qualifications:

Club with coaches up to Level 3 (Club Coach): (gymnasts up to NDP level)

Should have judges up to minimum level 2 [Club]

Clubs with coaches up to Level 4 (Senior Club Coach):

Should have judges up to minimum level 3 [Regional]

Clubs with coaches at Level 5 (High Performance Coach):

Should have level 4 or 5 [National or Brevet] judges

NB: It is considered good practice for coaches to hold a judging qualification appropriate to their level!
