The maximum number of official accreditations for this event we are permitted to nominate is detailed below:

*Minimum coaching qualifications:*

<b>TRA</b>	UKCC Level 2 / Club Coach (minimum) (L3.1 & L3.2 or above desirable)
<b>DMT</b>	DMT Senior Club Coach
<b>TUM</b>	UKCC Level 3.1 or above

Coach Criteria:

- *Hold the minimum coach qualification (see table below)*
- *Be able to attend the full inter-regional competition (including Friday podium/orientation)*
- *Demonstrate experience of coaching gymnasts at BG competitions*

Coaches will be required to meet the minimum standards as detailed in the above criteria. In addition to these, selection will be based upon:

- *The skills and strengths each coach can contribute to the team*
- *Each coach's ability to work with others*
- *Their ability to support gymnasts in a competition environment*

Prospective applicants should be aware that this is a self-funded event and at present no subsidy will be provided.

The aim of the selection panel will be to select the team of coaches / chaperones who will create and foster the most collaborative team environment and provide the best support to the gymnasts.

*Coaches should also be aware that even if selected for the team, there is no guarantee that they will be able to coach their own club's gymnasts at the event. The Lead Coach, depending upon the competition timetable and the requirements during each flight, will allocate gymnasts coaches.*
