	<p>TUM: Gymnasts who place in the top 2 at the Qualification Event in June, achieve the required qualification score, and achieve a pass in range and conditioning may be entered into the competition.</p> <p>TRA: Gymnasts who complete both exercises and meet all minimum standards (as per Competition Handbook) at each of the Qualification Events will be awarded ranking points. Final rankings will be calculated using each gymnast’s best 2 sets of points over the 3 Qualification Events. The top 2 gymnasts in the final rankings, provided they also have achieved a pass in range and conditioning, may be entered into the competition.</p> <p>DMT: Gymnasts who complete all four exercises, meet all minimum standards (as per Competition Handbook), and achieve the required qualification score at each of the Qualification Events will be awarded ranking points. Final rankings will be calculated using each gymnast’s best 2 sets of points over the 3 Qualification Events. The top 2 gymnasts in the final rankings, provided they also have achieved a pass in range and conditioning, may be entered into the competition.</p> <p>Further detail below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trampoline: Top 2 gymnasts, per level, per (eligible) age group, per gender • Tumbling: Top 2 gymnasts, per level, per (eligible) age group, per gender • Double-mini-trampoline: Top 2 gymnasts, per level, per (eligible) age group, per gender • Trampoline disability: Top 2 gymnasts, per level, per (eligible) age group, per gender <p>There will also be a team competition for trampoline, double-mini-trampoline, tumbling and disabilities.</p>

<p>Gymnasts' Eligibility for Selection</p>	<p>Gymnasts are eligible for consideration provided they:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hold a current Scottish Gymnastics silver membership • Comply with Scottish Gymnastics UKAD (UK Anti-Doping) Clean Sport policy at all times • Only represent the region in which their club is situated • Meet the in-age criteria for each Regional Challenge Cup level category. <p>Gymnasts must attend the qualification event (TUM) or at least one of the qualification events (TRA & DMT).</p>

To be considered for selection, the qualifying event/s must be attended, and the qualification criteria achieved.

Tumble

3rd April 2022 - Regional Challenge Cup Qualifier 1

8th May 2022 - Regional Challenge Cup Qualifier 2

12th June 2022 – Regional Challenge Cup Qualifier*

**Top 10 qualifiers from Regional Challenge Cup Qualifiers 1 & 2 will progress to this event*

Top 2 gymnasts from the Regional Challenge Cup Qualifier to be selected.

Trampoline & DMT

12th & 13th March 2022 - Regional Challenge Cup Qualifier 1

28th & 29th May 2022 - Regional Challenge Cup Qualifier 2

18th & 19th June 2022 – Regional Challenge Cup*

**Subject to meeting requirements at Qualifiers 1 & 2*

Top 2 highest ranked gymnasts over the 3 above events to be selected.

Following qualification, clubs with gymnasts who have qualified will receive a selection letter.

Selection letters will be issued week beginning 20th June. If selected gymnasts are unable to accept their selection to attend the Inter-Regional Challenge Cup Finals, they should let Scottish Gymnastics know by Monday 27th June to allow the next placed gymnast to be considered for selection.

At any stage following the selection announcement, should there be a doubt over the ability of any selected gymnast's competition readiness, the gymnast may be withdrawn following recommendation by the nominated head coach of the discipline to events@scottishgymnastics.org which will be discussed with an independent technical panel member.


The 'Team'	The 'team' means those who are selected by Scottish Gymnastics and includes gymnasts and personal coaches.
Appeals	The appeals process is only applicable to de-selection relating to injury/illness/competition readiness which can be found on here
Team Organisation	Gymnasts and coaches will travel independently to and from the competition venue.
Entry Information and Costs	<p>The entry fee is £55 per gymnast for first discipline entered and £17.50 per gymnast for each additional discipline entered.</p> <p>Clubs must complete the online JotForm which will be sent to qualified gymnasts via their club in the selection letters, confirming their gymnasts' attendance, and paying their entry fees by the deadline.</p>
Attire & Costs	<p>Gymnasts must wear the following items at the event. Gymnasts who already have the Kukri items are not required to purchase again.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scotland regional Quatro Competition Leotard * New design for 2022• Scotland regional Kukri Leggings• Scotland regional Kukri tracksuit top <p>Additional optional items for gymnasts are the Scotland regional Kukri top and Scotland regional Kukri tracksuit pants.</p> <p>Coaches must wear the following items at the event. Coaches who already have these items are not required to purchase again.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scotland regional Kukri polo shirt• Scotland regional kukri tracksuit top <p>Additional optional items for coaches are Scotland regional Kukri tracksuit tapered/straight pants.</p> <p>All kit will be ordered through the Kukri & Quatro online shops.
